Primary Tumor (T)

cT1 Expand

cN2 Expand
Bilateral metastasis in cervical lymph node(s), 6 cm or smaller in greatest dimension, above the caudal border of cricoid cartilage

Distant Metastasis (M)

cM0 Expand
No distant metastasis
